About our speaker:

Marika Barnett – Marika (Shweitzer) Barnett, was born in Budapest, Hungary in 1928. Her family lived there until 1944, when the Germans occupied Hungary. Fearing for her safety, Marika’s parents sent her to a Convent in the hills of Buda where about 110 Jewish children were already in hiding. She will be telling the story of her experience as a “hidden child” and that of her family.

Marika finished high school in 1952 and went on to receive her Master’s Degree in Psychology and Education. She fled Communist rule after the 1956 Hungarian Revolution and has been living in the US since. She worked in the computer industry for 25 years, and after retirement has become a published photographer and an award-winning playwright.
